Participants at the South Queensland Archery Society events are required to follow the following principals and exhibit the following behaviours.

Sanctions may be applied where participants do not follow this code and these sanctions may include exclusion or withdrawal of membership.

Code of Behaviour – Participants

1. Play by the rules.
2. Learn and follow archer's etiquette on the shooting line and while scoring.
3. Never argue with a judge, the Director of Shooting or Field Captain, or other official.
4. Control your temper.
5. Work equally hard for yourself and your team/club. Your team's performance will benefit and so will you.
6. Be a good sport. Applaud all good performances made by your team/club and the competition.
7. Treat other participants in the sport as you would like to be treated.
8. Cooperate with your coach, team mates and opponents.
9. Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit, not just to please others.
10. Respect the rights of all other participants.
11. Abide by all Archery Australia and South Queensland Archery Society Policies and follow all Procedures.
