

Code of Ethics – Officials

Officials at the South Queensland Archery Society events shall follow the following Code of Ethics.

Sanctions may be applied where officials, including judges, do not follow this code and these sanctions may include removal as an official at SQAS events.

For events where official Judges are required, Judges shall be qualified as Archery Australia judges.

Code of Ethics – Officials (including Judges)

1. Place the safety and welfare of the participants above all else.
2. Be impartial.
3. Avoid any situation that may lead to a conflict of interest.
4. Be courteous, respectful and open to discussion and interaction.
5. Value the individual in the sport.
6. Seek continual self-improvement through study, performance appraisal and regular updating of competencies.
7. Be a positive role model in behaviour and personal appearance.
8. Do not harass athletes.
9. Show concern and caution towards sick and injured athletes.
