Policy: Sponsorship

Policy

SQAS shall support archers representing the RGB or traveling overseas representing Australia, subject to budgetary limitations, to certain nominated tournaments.

Detail

International Competition

Archers who have been selected by Archery Australia for the World Archery - World Target Championships, WA - World Youth Target Championships, WA - World Indoor Championships and the WA - World Field Championships, WA – World Para Championships may apply for SQAS support.

Such application must be made as soon as possible after selection by Archery Australia and at the latest prior to departure from Australia. Applications should be by email to the Secretary SQAS at secretary@archerysqas.org.au

The nature of the support provided by SQAS shall be at the discretion of the SQAS Management Committee, and shall be subject to budgetary provisions, but shall not exceed \$200 per individual, except in exceptional circumstances.

Any financial support will be paid upon receipt of a claim form from an archer approved by the SQAS Management Committee, after attending the requisite event. In special circumstances payment may be made at other times.

National Competition

Archers attending the AA National Championships, the AA National Youth Championships and the AA National Indoor Championships, as part of the official SQAS Team may be provided support by SQAS.

Team Selection Policies will apply, including any registration requirements, the selection on the SQAS team and any conditions stipulated.

The nature of the support from SQAS shall be determined by the SQAS Management Committee, and may be by the way of the provision of uniforms, individual or team financial assistance, the provision of team management and coaching support, the payment of registration fees, transport etc., and shall be subject to budgetary provisions.

If any financial support is provided, the maximum shall be \$200 per individual, and this shall be provided post tournament, and on the recommendation of team management

and shall take into account behaviour and compliance with the team agreement, codes and policies. In special circumstances payment made be made at other times.

Conditions

SQAS may impose conditions for the receipt of support, which may include remaining financial and in good standing, acknowledgement of support, the wearing of uniforms, the requirement to follow directions of team management, and the compliance with codes of behaviour and policies.
