



2021 Indoor Archery World Series *Local Venue Entry Information*

Samford Valley Target Archers

For the 2020/2021 season, World Archery has announced a worldwide Virtual Tournament and Archery Australia has officially registered South Queensland Archery Society/Samford Valley Target Archers as a registered local venue.

Please read and follow the instructions for the tournament.

If you wish to participate at the registered venue that has been arranged by SQAS follow the 'How to Enter' instructions below. You must register and pay the tournament fee by the due date.

The cost and SQAS registration cover all 4 stages.

Entries Close: Friday 13 November at 23.00 (11pm)

Entries will be limited to 36 entries so book early. Late entries will not be accepted.

Calendar:

- Stage 1: Sunday 22 November 2020
- Stage 2: Sunday 20 December 2020
- Stage 3: Sunday 17 January 2021
- Stage 4: Sunday 14 February 2021

Arrangements for a Final, for teams only, will be determined should a team reach this stage, and would be held on 27-28 February 2021.

Cost: \$120

This is an open event only (no age divisions or other categories) and all archers will shoot the WA Indoor 18m round of 60 arrows, however archers have a choice of face, 40cm single spot, triple spot vertical, or triple spot triangle, with Compounds counting the inner 10. WA rules shall apply.

Bow types/Gender:

- Barebow Recurve Women
- Barebow Recurve Men
- Compound Women
- Compound Men
- Recurve Women
- Recurve Men

Flights:

The event will be run over a number of flights. Flight times and target allocations will be determined when entries have closed. Flights may start quite early in the morning and go quite late in the evening, dependent on the number of entries.

Flight times and groups/target allocations will be posted on the SQAS website www.archerysqas.org.au by 23.00 (11pm) on Wednesday 18 November 2020.

How to Enter:

1. Register with WA by following the [WA instructions](#), and
2. Also register with SQAS on-line via www.archerysqas.org.au or, use the following link, <https://eventdesq.sportstg.com/index.cfm?fuseaction=main&EventDesqID=36862&OrgID=8390> pay by credit card or Paypal.
PLEASE NOTE: you will have to enter your WA OpenWAREOS number when registering with SQAS.

Scoring:

You will be responsible for your entry into WAREOS and scoring entry into the Ianseo Scorekeeper application on your smart device. You will also need to print out and bring with you the hardcopy score sheet that WA will send you which will include a QR code for linking with WAREOS.

SQAS and SVTA do not have access to this part of the process.

Notes:

There will be no food available at the venue however Samford Village is a short drive from the venue and has many food outlets.

This tournament will be shot under WA and AA rules, SQAS and SVTA policies. Covid restrictions and requirements may apply.

Score sheets must be submitted to the Organising Committee within 15 minutes of the end of a flight or the score sheet will not be accepted.
