MEDALS

Archery Australia medals (National) - Gold, Silver, and Bronze on a National basis as resolved by off the bow position on Archers Diary for the two rounds shot.

Archery Australia medals (Regional) - Gold, Silver, and Bronze for the regional place getters (RGB Level) as resolved by off the bow position on Archers Diary for the two rounds shot.

Under 14	anyone born in the year 2010 or younger
Under 16	anyone born in the years 2008or 2009

Compound, Recurve, Longbow, Barebow Compound, Barebow Recurve
