Lismore City Archers motion to change the Silver Arrow Target event. Effective from 1st January 2024, distances for all bow types and age division to be reworked based on WA and AA 1440 rounds less 10m for all divisions (where possible) except for Compound and Recurve, Open and Under 21 men which will be 20m less. Maximum distance for archers with less than 12 months experience will be 40m. All rounds will be shot on a 122cm face. See table below for proposed distances.
