



SPONSORSHIP POLICY

Policy

South Queensland Archery Society (SQAS) archers selected by Archery Australia (AA) or SQAS to represent Australia or SQAS at official International / National events may apply for support to attend the events as listed in this policy.

The maximum amount of support for each event is listed within the Policy. These amounts will be subject to budgetary limitations.

Events that are NOT listed in the Policy will not be eligible for support from SQAS.

International Competition

Archers who have been selected by Archery Australia to compete at the following events will be eligible for support from SQAS:

Event	Maximum support
WA - World Target Championships	\$500
WA - World Youth Target Championships	\$500
WA - World Field Championships	\$500
WA - World Para Championships	\$500
WA - World Games	\$500
Olympic Games	\$500
Para Olympic Games	\$500
Commonwealth Games	\$500
Trans Tasman	\$300

Any financial support will be paid upon receipt of a claim form from an archer and approval by the SQAS Management Committee.

Archer applications for support using the SQAS Claim Form should be forwarded by email to the Treasurer SQAS at treasurer@archerysqas.org.au after attending the requisite event.

In special circumstances payment may be made at other times.

National Competition

Archers attending the AA National Target Championships, the AA National Youth Archery Championships, as part of the official SQAS Team may be provided support by SQAS.

Team Selection Policies will apply, including any registration requirements, selection on the SQAS team and any conditions stipulated.



SPONSORSHIP POLICY

The nature of the support from SQAS shall be determined by the SQAS Management Committee, and may be by the way of the provision of uniforms, individual or team financial assistance, the provision of team management and coaching support, the payment of registration fees, transport etc., and shall be subject to budgetary provisions.

If any financial support is provided, the maximum shall be \$250 per event, and this shall be provided post tournament, and on the recommendation of team management and shall take into account behaviour and compliance with the team agreement, codes and policies.

Archer applications for support using the SQAS Claim Form should be forwarded by email to the Treasurer SQAS at treasurer@archerysqas.org.au after attending the requisite event.

In special circumstances payment may be made at other times.

Conditions

SQAS may impose conditions for the receipt of support, which may include remaining financial and in good standing, acknowledgement of support, the wearing of uniforms, the requirement to follow directions of team management, and the compliance with codes of behaviour and policies.

Other matters

At its sole and absolute discretion, the SQAS Management Committee's decisions with respect to this Policy and the interpretation of the criteria in this Policy shall be final.
