MATCHPLAY ROUNDS:

Compound

Each archer will shoot the distance and face of their respective ranking rounds.
Male and female will be separate divisions – i.e. 2 divisions – Male and Female Compound.
Under 18, Under 21, Open, 50+, 60+ and 70+ classes will be included in combined matchplay.

Recurve

Each archer will shoot the distance and face of their respective ranking rounds.
Male and female will be separate divisions – i.e. 2 divisions – Male and Female Recurve.
Under 18, Under 21, Open, 50+, 60+ and 70+ classes will be included in combined matchplay.

All unsighted bows

Each archer will shoot the distance and face of their respective ranking rounds.
Under 18, Under 21, Open, 50+, 60+ and 70+ classes will be included in combined matchplay.

Under 14 and Under 16 - the format, whether round robin or elimination matchplay will be determined once the number who have entered is known and will be advised on the day. Male and Females, and divisions combined if needed.

CHAMPIONSHIPS WINNERS:

Medals for the SQAS Matchplay champions will be awarded immediately after shooting has finished.

CLASS:

Under 14	anyone born in the year 2013 or younger
Under 16	anyone born in the years 2011 or 2012
Under 18	anyone born in the years 2009 or 2010
Under 21	anyone born in the years 2006 ,2007 or 2008
Open	anyone born in 1977 to 2005 inclusive
50+	anyone born in the years 1967 to 1976
60+	anyone born in 1957 to 1966 inclusive
70+	anyone born in or before 1956
Para Open	Regardless of age, class is designated as Open
VI1	Regardless of age, class is designated as Open
VI2/VI3	Regardless of age, class is designated as Open

All Under 14, Under 16, Under 18 and Under 21 archers may elect to compete in a higher class, up to and including Open, by entering in the higher class, paying the appropriate fee and shooting the round for that class.

All 50+, 60+ and 70+ archers may elect to compete in a lower class, down to and including Open, by entering in the lower class and shooting the round for that class.

DIVISION:

Compound, Recurve, Longbow, Barebow Compound, Barebow Recurve

ENTRY CANCELLATION POLICY

SQAS may cancel an event if a criteria for cancellation, as enunciated within the event invitation, is met - e.g. a minimum number of entries required.

The event may also be cancelled for reasons outside the control of SQAS e.g. due to inclement weather or relevant authority that requires cancellation of the event (e.g. Covid restrictions).

EVENT ENTRY REFUND POLICY

- full refund of the entry fees paid where the event is cancelled by the Organisers.
- 90% refund of the entry fee paid where the entrant withdraws from the event prior to registration cut-off.
- no refund (except in extenuating circumstances) where the entrant withdraws after registration cut-off.

NOTES:

As electronic scoring via Archers Diary will be available for this event, all archers are responsible for ensuring your scores are entered into Archers Diary at the completion of the event.

This tournament will be shot under World Archery, Archery Australia and SQAS rules and policies.

Competitors are to ensure that you bring your current AA membership card (physical or digital) with you as you may not participate without proof of current membership.

Please advise the organisers if you have any issues with photos being taken by the official photographer.

Please remember to slip, slop, slap, and use insect repellent before shooting, and drink plenty of water during the event. Drinks, chocolates, chips, water etc. will be available from the canteen. Lunch will NOT be available. There are several take-away outlets a short drive away in Samford Village.
